Rules and Regulations:

ADMISSION:

All admissions are non-transferable and non-refundable. The Director will not entertain any requests for refund / transfer of fees.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

Two copies each of the following self-attested documents must be submitted:

1. Statement of marks of HSC or Diploma
2. Passing certificate of HSC or Diploma
3. Degree certificate or mark list of any other degree
4. Affidavit for change in name (if applicable)
5. Photographs (4)

SCREENING TEST:

On the very first day of the programme, the students will be given a screening test in English language skills. The test is free and compulsory.

LEAVE:

- Students absent for 3 consecutive days will have to furnish a written explanation.
- Only submission of application without approval does not mean sanction of leave.

ELIGIBILITY FOR FINAL EXAMINATION:

- Minimum 75% attendance in each course is mandatory to be eligible for the final exams.
- The student should take all the internal assignments during the course as per schedule. Assessment by the teacher will be final.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

- Students should not go out for any personal work during class hours.
- All Symbiosis campuses are non-smoking zones. Students should not smoke within the institute premises. Any student seen smoking will have to pay a fine of Rs. 500/-.
- Students have to pay a nominal parking fee to the parking attendant or obtain a parking pass for the duration of the course.
- Students should always carry their I-cards in the institute campus and at all official events.
- Use of cellphones is not permitted during class. The phone will be confiscated by the teacher/staff, if the student is found using it.
